



Skin Science Aesthetics Scholarship

- **Award:** \$500 - \$2,500
- **Deadline:** at least 2 weeks prior to class start date
- **Description:** This scholarship is for students enrolling in Aesthetic Laser Institute that leads to certification, in order to learn a marketable skill that will lead to economic self-sufficiency. To qualify for this scholarship, applicants must be a mature student, be over 18 years of age, and graduated from an accredited High School or an equivalent level institution.

 1. Write down the three accomplishments of which you are the most proud.
 2. Develop a list of your extracurricular activities.
 3. Think of a problem that you have faced and write down how you were able to overcome it.
 4. Put in writing your career goals, or your reason for wanting to attend Aesthetic Laser Institute.
 5. Pretend that you had to write a letter of recommendation for yourself. Write down the three most important things you would say.
 6. Write a 300-500 word essay explanation in your own words of how Aesthetic Laser Institute will benefit your life.
